PARENT TEACHER MEETING - 13th July, 2019

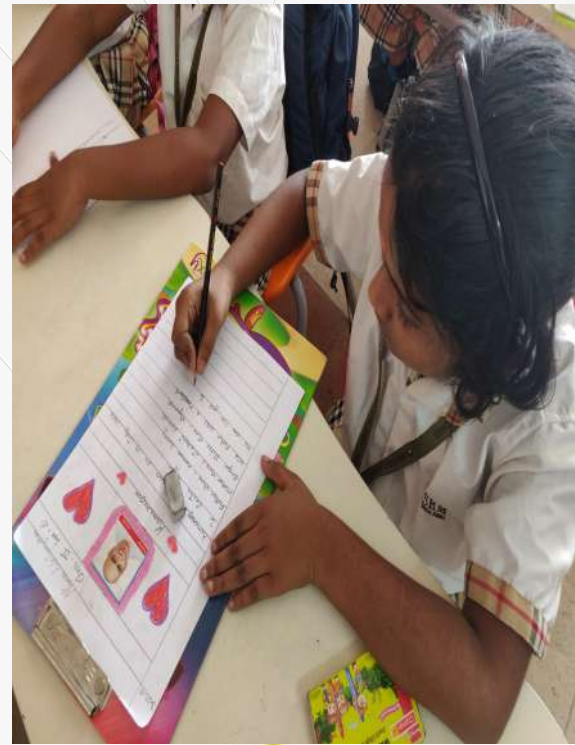

Sense Booth - 27th July, 2019

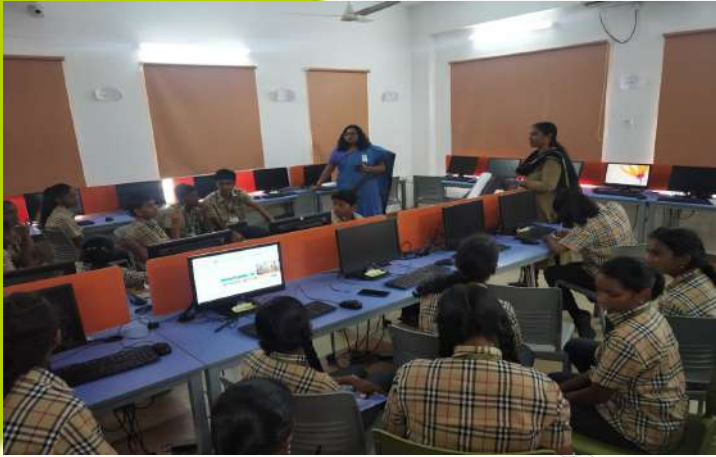

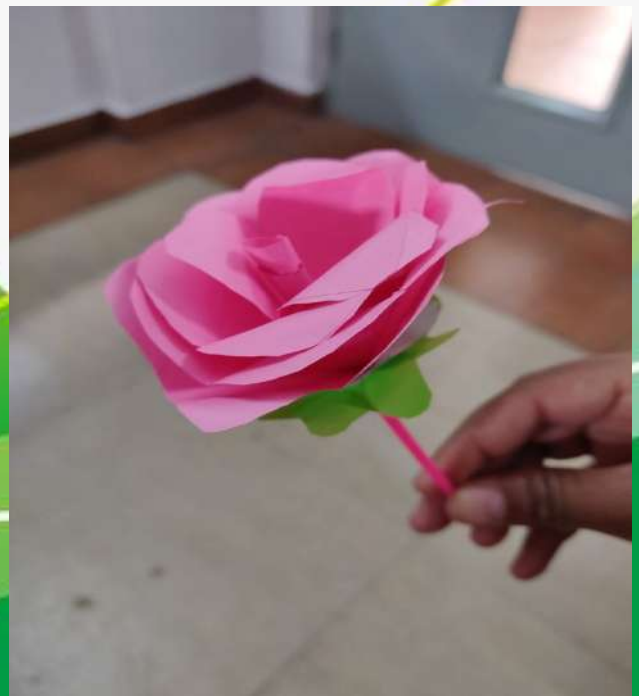
