ENGINEERING TOMORROW: ROBOFUSION 2025 UNLEASHES STUDENT INNOVATION



SRM Public School proudly hosted RoboFusion 2025, a spectacular inter-state robotics competition that celebrated innovation, creativity, and technological excellence among young learners. The event transformed the campus into a buzzing hub of futuristic ideas, welcoming nearly 200 passionate student innovators from 70 schools across Chennai, Tamil Nadu, and neighbouring states.

Designed to ignite curiosity and strengthen problem-solving skills, RoboFusion 2025 showcased the power of student-driven engineering through three high-intensity, skill-based challenges, each demanding precision, strategy, and teamwork.

The adrenaline-packed Robo Rush saw remotely controlled robotic vehicles racing through a specially engineered obstacle course, testing speed, navigation skills, and control accuracy. Robologix challenged participants to demonstrate logic and efficiency as robots identified, picked, and transported colour-coded blocks to assigned stations within a demanding three-second operational window. The excitement peaked with Torque Trails, a fiercely competitive robotic tug-of-war that pushed the limits of power, stability, and structural design.

The competition not only tested technical skills but also encouraged bold thinking and fearless innovation, inspiring students to explore real-world engineering applications.

The valedictory ceremony was graced by Mrs. Pavithra Aroon, education consultant, entrepreneur, and social impact advocate. She is the Founder of SNAP Consulting, an Aberdeen-based organisation in the UK, specialising in generative AI for educators and EdTech solutions for gifted and SEN learners. Her address emphasised the importance of ethical innovation and the evolving role of AI and robotics in education.

Adding to the inspiration, the Chief Guest, Dr. Ananthkumar, Associate Director, SRMIST, delivered an engaging address highlighting how robotics and emerging technologies are shaping future careers and driving global solutions.

Winners were rewarded with cash prizes worth nearly ₹1,00,000, along with trophies, medals, and certificates for the top three teams in each category. The prestigious Overall Championship Trophy was proudly claimed by Sree Gokulam Public School, Chengalpet, in recognition of their outstanding performance across events.
