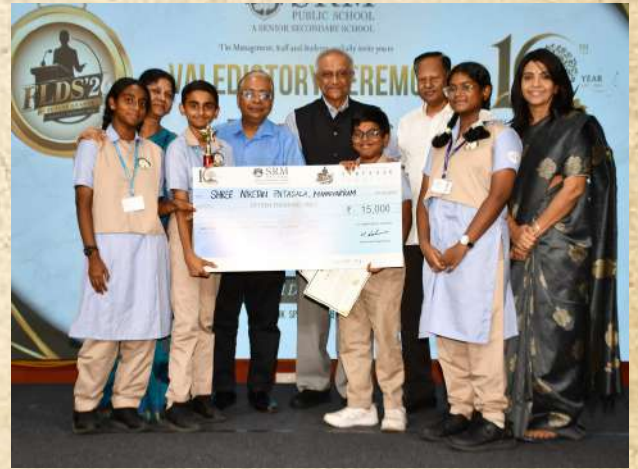

THE FUTURE LEADER DEBATE SUMMIT 2026 – SRMPS 10TH YEAR GLORY

As part of its 10th Anniversary celebrations, SRM Public School proudly hosted the Future Leaders Debate Summit (FLDS) 2026, a prestigious inter-school debate championship that brought together over 320 students from 33 schools across Chennai and neighbouring districts. Conducted in the Modified World Schools Debate Championship (WSDC) format, the summit provided a dynamic platform for students to strengthen their critical thinking, persuasive communication, leadership, and analytical skills through meaningful and evidence-based discussions. The championship featured 24 teams in Category A (Classes IX & X) and 31 teams in Category B (Classes XI & XII). Following the preliminary knockout rounds held on 22 July 2026, the shortlisted teams competed in the qualifying rounds and the grand finale on 31 July 2026, showcasing exceptional debating abilities and intellectual excellence.

Adding a unique dimension to the event, the summit introduced innovative competition segments such as the Silent Debate, Media Room Challenge, One Minute Fire, and Leadership Café, which challenged participants to think critically, communicate effectively, and collaborate creatively under diverse formats. Students debated several contemporary and socially relevant topics, including net neutrality, mandatory community service in schools, lowering the voting age, peer pressure among adolescents, nationalism among youth, and the inclusion of emotional intelligence as a core school subject. Their articulate arguments, thoughtful rebuttals, and respectful engagement reflected their ability to analyse complex issues with maturity and confidence.

The championship featured a prize purse of ₹60,000, along with prestigious individual awards such as Best Speaker, Best Rebuttal Speaker, Young Thought Leader, and recognitions for outstanding performances in the summit's special competition segments. Mr. M. Subramanian, Correspondent, and Dr. K. R. Maalathi, Advisor, welcomed the gathering and reaffirmed the school's commitment to nurturing future-ready leaders through meaningful academic initiatives. The Valedictory Ceremony was graced by Dr. Sridhar Krishnaswami, Scholar-in-Residence and Visiting Professor
